



Individual Membership Services

The mission of the Volunteer Centre of Guelph/Wellington:

To strengthen our communities through volunteerism and access to community information.

To become an individual member of the Volunteer Centre of Guelph/Wellington you must meet the following criteria:

- Be an individual (e.g. not an agency/organization or corporation) 18 years of age and older who resides, works, volunteers or accesses services in the City of Guelph or the County of Wellington
- Support the mission statement of the Volunteer Centre of Guelph/Wellington
- Complete and submit the *Individual Membership Application Form*

As an individual member, the benefits of membership include:

- One vote at our Annual General Meeting
- Copy of our print newsletter (3x/year) and electronic newsletter (monthly)
- Access to the information and resources of the Volunteer Centre including borrowing privileges
- Invitations to all workshops and events hosted by the Volunteer Centre of Guelph/Wellington
- Reduced rates for workshops, events and training opportunities
- Eligible for nomination to a Committee (Standing or Ad-Hoc) and/or the Board of Directors of the Volunteer Centre of Guelph/Wellington (Nominations must be approved by the Board of Directors or general membership of the Volunteer Centre, as applicable)

Membership fee is \$50.00 annually.

Membership fees are accepted throughout the year with yearly memberships due each April.

Individuals must have purchased their membership a minimum of 30 days prior to each year's Annual General Meeting to be allowed voting privileges at that meeting.

The Volunteer Centre of Guelph/Wellington reserves the right to terminate the membership of any individual who fails to comply with the above criteria.

All membership applications are reviewed by the Executive Director of the Volunteer Centre of Guelph/Wellington.
